A New On-Screen Upgrade for Our Live Televised Mass!

Thousands of Appreciative Viewers Join Us for September 11 Live TV Mass Honoring 15th Anniversary of 9/11

We deeply appreciate the many kind comments and expressions of gratitude from the many viewers who tuned in to our live Mass telecast on Sunday, September 11, for a special Liturgy in commemoration of the 15th anniversary of the Attack on America in 2001.

The special Blue Mass honored the nearly 3,000 persons who died on that fateful day, as well as all who continue to serve the public as firefighters, police, and emergency medical personnel.

All local First Responders were invited to wear their uniforms to the Mass and were assigned a place of honor in the front of Saint John Gualbert Cathedral in Johnstown.

Evonne Yanzetich-Homway, Cathedral Director of Music and Chief Organist, prepared a special program of music appropriate for the occasion, reflecting the meaning and purpose of the event, as well as its implications for succeding generations.

Our live TV Mass soon will have a new improved appearance thanks to two much-needed on-screen upgrades.

The first involves the installation of a new character generator, the electronic computer-based device which creates and displays all of the onscreen graphics during the Mass telecast.

The second and related urgrade centers on a new Mass opening, which establishes the theme and

atmosphere for the Liturgy.

The immediate need for the new character generator became evident when our present unit, more than a decade old, crashed a few Live Sundays 11:00 am

weeks earlier. Our Chief Engineer Joe Delso did a quick search of the internet and found a used unit similiar to ours in Rochester, New York, and had it sent to us by Express Mail Overnight.

After several hours of work over a two-day period Joe was able to get the equipment on line in time for our Blue Mass telecast on September 11.

Meanwhile, we are ordering a new state-of-the-art generator incorporating the latest advances at a cost of \$7,000.00, which we hope to have in operation by the end of Ootober.

At the same time, **Dale and Becky Wicks**, owners of WIX PIX Productions of suburban Johnstown, are in the process of preparing a new Mass opening designed to give a fresh perspective to our live telecast.

Dale and Becky have always been friends of our TV Ministry through their support and the donation of their creative skills and used equipment.
