It would be good for parishes with new RCIA Team Members, and veteran members who need updating or want to delve more into the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, to attend the **Catechumenate Team Ministry Course**. It is necessary for the class to have a minimum of eight participants for the course to be held and at this time we are at five. We have extended the RSVP registration date to Tuesday, September 20, 2016.

Course sessions are on Thursday evenings at the Diocese of Altoona-Johnstown Administration Center, Building B, 933 South Logan Blvd, Hollidaysburg from 6:30 PM – 9:00 PM. The fee is \$75.00 for all books and supplies. The fee is \$60.00 for adults who already own a Study Edition of the Rite book. (Please bring your Rite book to class.)

The bi-annual Catholic Life Day of Prayer being held during the Year of Mercy on Saturday, October 22nd in the Bertshci Center at Mount Aloysius College, is a prayerful opportunity for Catholics to share with others from various parishes in the Diocese of Altoona-Johnstown. As part of the day there will be a “showcasing” of parishes, schools, and diocesan and local, national and international community service involvement. We are inviting all parish and school groups and organizations to “showcase” their community service experiences and efforts by making a tri-fold display board that will be placed on tables in the gathering space of the Bertshci Center. You may include brochures with your display.

Displays should be no larger than five feet (half a large table.) Everyone who has a display should try to stay for the day of prayer to be at your table to offer information and answer any questions people may have. Information for set-up times will be available by October 10. Displays should be ready by 8:00 AM as many people do come early.

The day begins at 9:00 AM with the Liturgy of the Hours Morning Prayer, Bishop Mark as Presider, and continue with coffee/tea and juice, breakfast items and exhibit time. During the day there will be two keynote presentations by Sr. Janet Ruffing, R.S.M. currently a professor at Yale University, Connecticut; lunch; round table discussions with personal focus on living the Corporal and Spiritual Work of Mercy; large group reflection time led by Sr. Janet. *Witnesses of Mercy*, (Men, women, youth and young adults), will share stories of faith and conversion that are the result of living the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy.
