Dear Brother and Sisters in Christ,

At the family dinner table, Emily was talking with great enthusiasm about the extra steps in the parish faith formation program because she was preparing to receive her First Holy Communion. Her two older siblings were offering words of advice and encouragement, sounding like they had been receiving the sacrament for ages. Emily's five-year-old brother was quiet the whole time. I need your financial support, your generous contribution. There is no other source of funding for these ministries. 100% of your gift goes directly to these efforts. I have already made my pledge. Please join me.


It's easy to understand why Frankie wasn't ready to take on what he perceived as a responsibility. Please remember that whenever we participate in the life-giving work of
