IMPORTANT CAMP TIMOTHY INFORMATION

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

High School students entering grades 10-12 and newly graduated seniors.

Since Camp Timothy is staffed by volunteers and college students, we are not equipped to handle students with special needs.

CAMP TIMOTHY LEADERSHIP

The Camp Director, the Camp Timothy Adult Staff and an outstanding group of counselors will be working with campers providing additional guidance and leadership.

WHAT IS THE COST?

For members of a parish within the Diocese of Altoona-Johnstown, cost is only \$365 per camper which includes all fees for additional camp activities (this year is caving).

Each camper will receive an official "Camp T" t-shirt. Since Camp is partially funded through the Annual Catholic Appeal, there is an additional fee of \$65 per child if your family is not registered at one of our parishes.

CABIN ASSIGNMENTS

Since we will only be accepting a limited number of campers, spots are first come, first serve basis. As registrations come in, we will add cabins as necessary based on the gender of campers. We cannot guarantee that campers will be housed with every person listed, but we will do our best to accommodate. Please list no more than three cabin mates per form.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

To register, fill out the application form, sign it, and send it with a \$50.00 (non-refundable) deposit per camper (list campers name in the memo line of your check). There is a \$50 fee for checks returned from the bank. Send fully completed and signed application with your check.

We are only accepting a limited number of campers, so registrations will be accepted on a first-come basis until camp is full. Since this is a diocesan sponsored camp which is supported by the Annual Catholic Appeal, campers from within the diocese will be given first priority. Once camp is full, we will start a waiting list to pull additional campers.

DEADLINE for registrations is May 27, 2022. The balance of remaining camp fees is due in the Youth Ministry Office no later than June 10, 2022 to ensure your child's spot at camp. Any fees unpaid at registration may be subject to a \$25 fee.

To obtain a Camp Timothy Angel Fund form, contact Francine Swope in the Diocesan Youth Ministry Office at (814)317-2646. Deadline for Angel Fund Applications to be submitted is May 15, 2022.

Once your registration is processed, you will receive an information packet which includes all of the necessary forms and information for Camp Timothy. Camper forms must be returned by June 10.
