- ~To register, fill out an application for EACH camper, sign it and send it with a \$50 (non-refundable) deposit per camper. Note: If there is a state or national shutdown, deposits will be refunded.
- ~The \$50 deposit will be deducted from the total cost of camp.
- ~The fee for one camper for 2023 is \$335 and \$325 for each additional camper in the same family.
- ~ Registration deadline is June 12th.
- ~Balance of remaining camp fees are due no later than July 12th to ensure your child's spot at camp. Any balance due at the day of camp opening will incur an additional \$25 fee.
- ~There is a \$75 fee for checks returned from the bank.
